Altmetric Ambassadors: A Guide to Getting Started


Thanks for your interest in the Altmetric Ambassadors program - we're very excited to have you on board!

As an Altmetric Ambassador, you will act as an advocate of altmetrics among your peers. This will involve promoting awareness of Altmetric tools, and educating others about the benefits of using Altmetric tools to discover and monitor the online conversations around their scholarship.

Here's how to get started with your Ambassadorial duties.

First steps

Learn how to talk about Altmetric data. Here's <u>a handy guide to properly describing altmetrics</u>, Altmetric, and the data we collect--have a read!



Read up on Altmetric tools via the Altmetric blog. The Altmetric blog contains a collection of useful posts that showcase free Altmetric tools and provides more information about Altmetric data in general. Here are some posts to get you started (<u>loads more can be found in this list</u>):

- <u>"Advice from a librarian: how to do successful altmetrics outreach"</u> and <u>"Planning an altmetrics workshop: themes to emphasize"</u>: These two guest posts by librarian Heather Coates (IUPUI) are great guides for those who want to do outreach to faculty or plan an altmetrics-related campus workshop.
- "<u>Altmetrics in action: applications for researchers</u>": A general, researcher-oriented introduction to altmetrics. Useful for teaching others how altmetrics can be applied in real-life contexts.
- "Numbers behind Numbers: The Altmetric Attention Score and Sources Explained": A common
 question that many people have about Altmetric data is related to how we calculate the Altmetric
 attention score. This guide will give you the lowdown on the different sources we track, and how
 we calculate the Altmetric attention score assigned to each research output.
- <u>"Teaching Altmetric: new training materials available!"</u>: Contains a solid collection of Altmetric-related training materials, including videos, slides, and more.

Getting into the groove

After you've completed the simple stuff, it's time to really dig in. Here are some ways you can promote altmetrics and Altmetric at your institution.

Schedule a brown bag on altmetrics. The best way to raise awareness of altmetrics (and Altmetric) is to offer a presentation that covers the basics. You don't need to reinvent the wheel, either--feel free to borrow liberally from existing Altmetric presentations, use this template slide deck, or swipe talking points on altmetrics from this guide (a similar set of talking points specifically on Altmetric can be found here). If you'd like to offer refreshments, we can help foot the bill!

Add Altmetric data to your online profiles. If you have a blog or personal website that includes a list of your research outputs (like articles, datasets, or presentations), you can display <u>Altmetric data or badges</u> by copying-and-pasting a few simple lines of code, which can be generated <u>here</u>.

Translate the <u>Altmetric slide deck</u> or any of our other resources into your language, to help spread the word in your region. We're also seeking help with translating our Explorer app--please email <u>jean@altmetric.com</u> for more information.
