Immediate observations in publication trends


- "sexual harassment" NOT metoo; N = 5921
- metoo NOT "sexual harassment"; N = 490
- metoo OR "sexual harassment"; N = 6552
- metoo AND "sexual harassment"; N = 141


The emergence of new terms - new identities - is always interesting. Sometimes 'metoo' is used as a synonym for 'sexual harassment', sometimes as a replacement. But also as an entity in its own right: the socialization of discourse about sexual harassment, and also as a possibly emergent field in viral discourse.

Let's look at comparative Google search volume for a broader view!




Sexual harassment (blue), metoo (red) - worldwide








Sexual harassment (blue), metoo (red) - USA





Sexual harassment (blue), metoo (red) - India








Dimensions publications on s.h NOT metoo



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




Funding levels for s.h OR metoo (blue - active, green - starting)






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



A few conclusions

- Regarding this research area: there is clear evidence that research and discourse - about research started growing before 'Weinstein'; but that the #metoo phenomena provided valuable focus - and also a 'hook' for discourse.
- There is a suggestion of a 'state of readiness' BUT I can't find a single mention of 'metoo' (in this context) in research literature pre #metoo
- The idea of the linear model is unhelpful: the research lifecycle is considerably more complex.
- As well as 'funder initiative' and 'scientific breakthrough', social pressure, academic interest play a vital role in shaping research.
- The more we surface the lifecycle's data, the more we can understand the phenomena.


Hélène obtained her PhD in social geography from the Cities Institute (London Metropolitan University). Her work was funded by SECOA, a EU 7th Framework project on the adaptation of coastal cities to sea-level rise, and her research focused on the inclusive participation of the general population in decisions about the future of open spaces in Portsmouth. Hélène has worked on many consultancy projects. For the CWASU research institute, she

worked on a project for the UK charity SOLACE, to map the evolution of abused women's social network over a two-year period. For S+G, a landscape architect company, she built a survey that incorporated a 2-week period of smartphone location/transportation tracking of students and staff on the campus of DTU, Denmark.

















Gender Balance in the Altmetric Top 100 2019 vs 2018: first authorship










Lack of diversity increases risk of tech product failures


Only four per cent of the UK tech industry is from BAME backgrounds






What Researchers Think About the Culture They Work In: Quantitative Dataset




