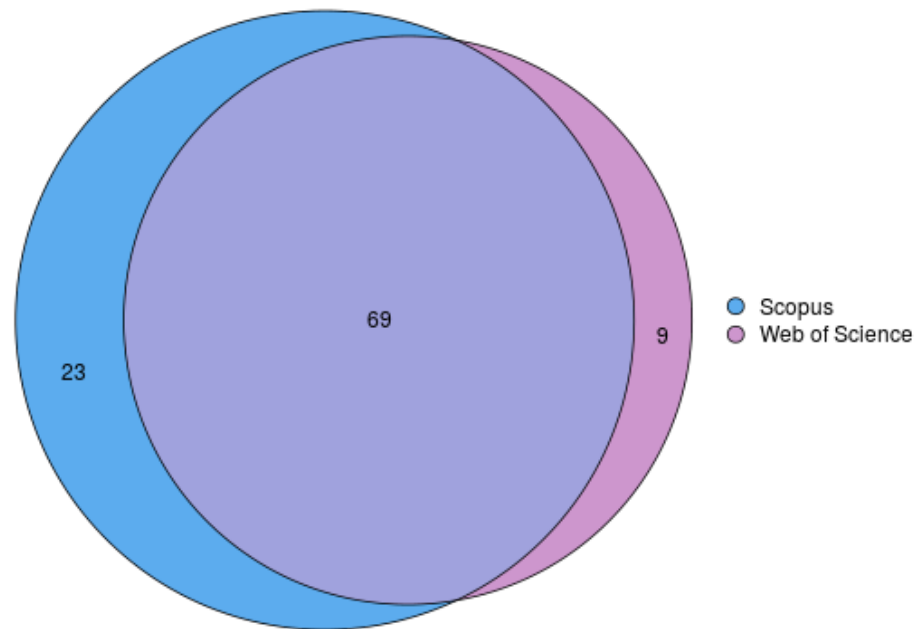

Overlap of 11,035 citations to 10 highly-cited documents in the field of Economics



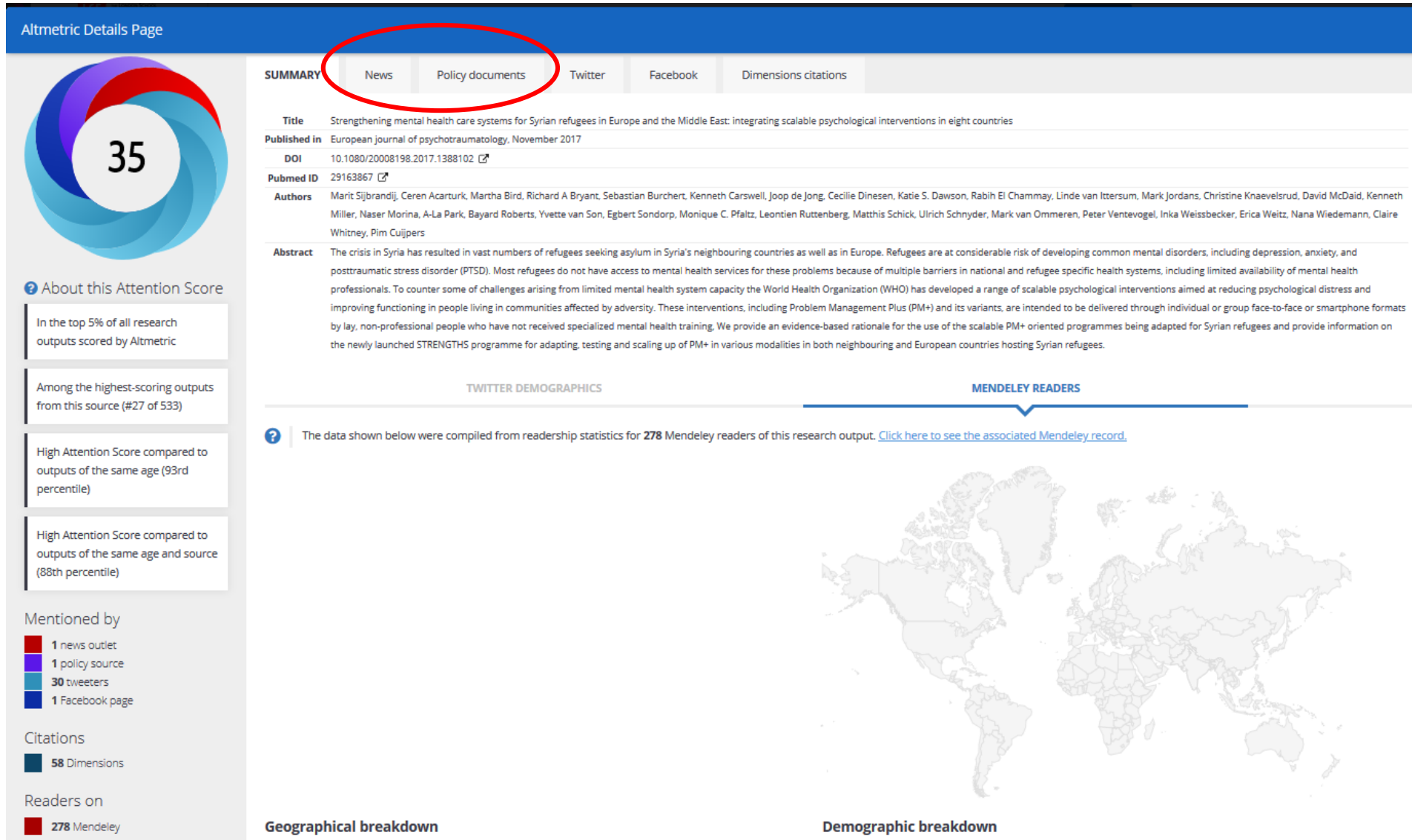
